

**Tour code 1012GVT: Vientiane-Xiengkhoung-Sam Neua-Nong Khiew-
Oudom Xay -Muang Sing-Xieng Kok-Luang Prabang-Vang Vieng -
Vientiane. 14days/13Night**

DAY01: Arrival at Vientiane. You will be welcomed to Laos by local Guide, transfer to hotel free at leisure dinner and overnight Vientiane.

DAY02: Vientiane - Xieng Khouang. (B/L/D)

After breakfast, a beautiful drive to Xieng Khouang, the site of the PLAIN OF JARS, traveling through the mountains. On the way, stop at a cave that was used as a hospital during the time the Americans were fighting the Vietnamese – Laos, although neutral, was bombed repeatedly during this time and suffered many casualties. Discover Plain of Jars. Visit the first site is biggest one over 300 jars and see sunset here.

DAY03: Xieng Khouang - Sam Neua. (B/L/D)

Drive for about 6-7 hours, you will enjoy driving through high mountain and hill tribe villages on the way. Lunch at local restaurant, arrive Sam Neua. Overnight Sam Neua hotel

DAY04: Explore the Leaders' Caves in Vieng Xay. (B/L/D)

In the morning, visit local fresh market, Vieng Xay: a revolutionary stronghold. Limestone peaks form a beautiful landscape around Vieng Xay. But hidden in these rocky crags are networks of Caves which were at the center of a vital period in Laos's history. During 1960s, Political developments in Laos were influential in the future of the whole region. The United States believed that Laos was crucial in the prevention of communist expansion, so this small country became caught up in the conflict between US and the Vietnamese, in 1964, the US began intensive bombing of the Lao communist movement-Patthet Lao. These limestone karst cave networks sheltered their headquarters during their struggle with American-backed Royal Lao Government. The story of this unique revolutionary stronghold is an important part of global political history of the period, the story of Vieng Xay also tells you about the Lao national communist movement, some hundreds of caves used for shelter have been preserved. DAY05: Sam Neua - Muang Vieng Thong. (B/L/D)

After breakfast, A beautiful drive through National Reservation NAM MED PHOU LEUY which is the tropical rain forest and you will learn the lifestyle of hill tribe villagers of Khmu, Hmong people and We pack picnic lunch eat on the way. You can enjoy take a bath hot springs open air with villagers Overnight the best Guesthouse.

DAY06: Muang Vieng Thong - Nong Khiew. (B/L/D)

After breakfast, continue your trip forward to Nong Kiew
You can make stop on the way for taking photos, Visit the Community Villagers of Ban Sop Hun village Production Lao Lao (Lao whisky 45% of alcohol) made of sticky rice welcome you test, arrive Nong Kiew. Overnight the best bungalow riverside

DAY07: Nong Kiew - Oudom Xay . (B/L/D)

After breakfast, we drive to Oudom Xay, We take for about 6-7 hrs to get there. Stop to visit hill tribe villages, we pack picnic lunch eat on the way, because on the way no restaurant. Overnight at hotel.

DAY08: Oudom Xay - Muang Sing. (B/L/D)

Today you will see more different minorities on the way to Luang Nam Tha, Ekor, Lan Taen, Khmu, Tai Dam and Tai Leu people, also a beauty of landscape.

We drive to Muang Sing, Also stop on the way to visit minority villages: Ekor, Lane Taen. After Lunch visit Ban Nam Ded, Ban Nam Mai Yao people and. overnight at hotel.

DAY09: Mouang Sing - Xieng Kok. (B/L/D)

Early morning visit fresh local market. A colorful minorities spend this market, then we drive to Xieng Kok is the Lao -Myanmar border at the Mekong river 70 km, you will enjoy to visit colorful minorities villages, Ekor, Lans Taen, Khmu,.. etc. Return back the same way to Muang Sing. Overnight at: Singjalearn Hotel

DAY10: Muang Sing - Oudom Xay. (B/L/D)

After breakfast, drive back the same way to Oudom Xay, Also make stop to visit villagers on the way, Clime up Phou That Stupa for over look the panoramic view of Oudom Xay. Check in Oudomkham Hotel

DAY11: Oudom Xay - Luang Prabang. (B/L/D)

After breakfast, drive back to Pakmong is the junction to Luang Prabang, after lunch in Luang Prabang, Take for sightseeing tour UNESCO city.

Wat Xiengthong Temple is the most beautiful temple and the oldest Wat was built in 1560, the only one was not destroyed by the war. Walk around city, then clime up Phousi hill for over looking the view of UNESCO Luang Prabang 328 steps to the top and watch sunset here. Overnight Phousi hotel or similar

DAY12: Pak OU Cave by boat. (B/L/D)

In the morning, visit National museum (Royal palace) which was collected the antiques keep inside included sacred Prabang Buddha statues.

we take by traditional boat up stream on Mekong River, which also gives you a beautiful view of the tranquil countryside as well as an interesting discover the mysterious Pak Ou Caves, crammed with thousands of lacquered Buddha statues of various shapes and sizes. Along the way, we stop at Ban Xanghai Village, where they make the distillation of local rice wine (made of sticky rice). After lunch return back the same boat to visit Buddhist temples. Overnight Phousi Hotel or similar

DAY13: Luang Prabang - VangVieng by Van. (B/L/D)

This morning you will drive to VANG VIENG, famed for its intricate network of limestone caves. There will be several stops on the way to see some Buddhas carved out of rocks in the forest, and one of the minority villages. We will spend some time exploring the caves before continuing to our peaceful guesthouse on the outskirts of town, away from the tourist hoards. Elephant Crossing Hotel.

DAY14: Vang Vieng - Vientiane. (B/L/D)

Drive to Vientiane is a Capital of Laos, take about 4 hrs, After lunch take sightseeing around Vientiane.

After lunch, taking for sight seeing tour to visit religious museum Wat Sisakhet Temple, the oldest temple, its cloister contains more than 8.000 Buddha statues, Hor Prakeo, the former home-temple of the Emerald Buddha statues, but today it contains a collections of Buddha statues, antiques and all artifacts found around Vientiane. Visit That Luang Stupa, the single most important monument in Laos, which was built to cover the original small stupa containing a piece of the chest of Buddha and walk along Mekong riverside with cool drink, until transfer to airport for your forward flight home.
